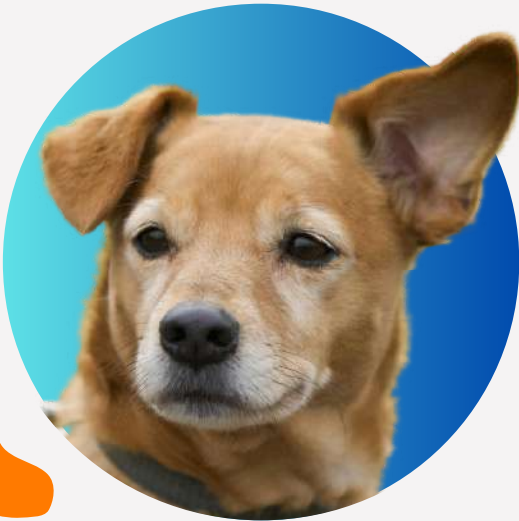


Why Does It Work?

Use It in Real-Time Situations

Timing is everything. If your dog is barking at the doorbell or jumping on guests, here's how to handle it:



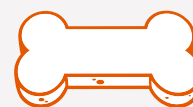
Wait for it

the behavior to start (e.g., barking or jumping).



Press the button

Briefly to emit the ultrasonic sound.



Reward them

As soon as they stop or pause, reward them with a treat or praise.

This helps them associate stopping the unwanted behavior with a positive outcome. It's like saying,

"See this Buddy? When you listen, good things happen!"





Pair It with Positive Reinforcement

The remote trainer is great for **grabbing their attention**, **but what keeps them motivated** will always be your praise and rewards.



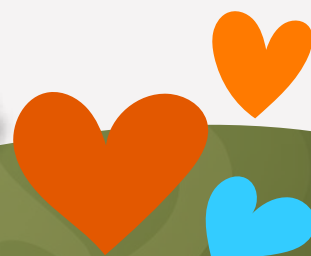
Treat Time

Practice Makes Perfect

Consistency is key!

Use the trainer during specific behaviors you want to address, but keep sessions short and focused.

Overusing the device can make it less effective or confuse your pet.

- **Stick to One Behavior at a Time:** Trying to tackle barking, jumping, and digging all at once might overwhelm your dog. Start with the most pressing issue and move on once they've mastered it.
- **End on a High Note:** Always finish training sessions with a positive interaction, like a cuddle or a fun game



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Common mistakes to avoid

Even the best tools won't work if they're used incorrectly. Here are some pitfalls to dodge:



Overusing the Device:

Don't rely on it for everything, or your dog might start ignoring it. Think of it as a nudge, not a megaphone.



Using It as Punishment:

This is not a "bad dog" button. It's a gentle way to redirect, not scold.

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How to recognize

If the device is stressing your pet

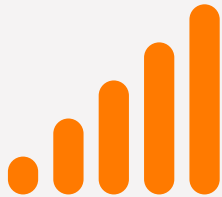

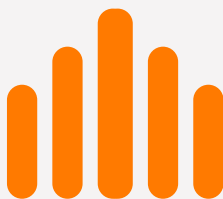
